SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, September 11

Stewart Park, Ithaca

5:00am- Early bird Crew Review

6:00am- Riders arrive at park

6:30am- Riders assemble for opening ceremony

6:45am- Opening Ceremony begins

7:00am- Ride Out for all 100 & 85 mile riders!

9:45am- Riders riding 42 miles gather at Stewart Park

10:30am- Bus departs with 42-milers to Seneca Falls

12:15pm- Riders riding 14 & 25 miles gather at Stewart Park

1:00pm - Bus departs with 14 & 25-milers

12:00pm- Riders begin arriving at Cass Park

5:00pm- Cass Park pit stop closes

PIT STOPS

There are 6 stops along the entire 100 mile route. They are clearly marked stops and will allow you to replenish food and drinks. Medical staff and facilities are available at each stop.

FINISH LINE LOCATION

Riders finish at Cass Park between 12:00pm and 5:00pm. Family and friends are encouraged to gather near the finish line and help celebrate the accomplishments of the riders but please spread out and try to head out after eating and picking up your rider gifts. A shuttle service between Cass and Stewart Park will be driving between the parks from 2:30pm to 5:30pm.

ADDITIONAL SCHEDULING INFORMATION

Rider Packet Pick-up, Friday, September 10th, 4-7pm

Riders will pick up their numbers, goodie bags and turn in any remaining donations to reach their \$200 dollar minimum.

Please be prepared to make up the difference with a personal check, MC or VISA, or cash or sign a promissory note.

Crew Reviews

All motorcyclists and support vehicles must attend a Crew Review to go over job responsibilities and logistics. Please plan on attending the review for 1 hour to allow time for paperwork and any material distribution.

Gear Drop

Riders may leave clothing at Stewart Park to be transported to the finish line at Cass Park. Clothing may also be left at any pit stop, and will be returned to Cass Park for you. Please label everything clearly so we can get your gear to you. If you would like to leave gear at Stewart, please leave them in a secure location like a vehicle as we will be closing down Stewart Park after all riders depart.

Weather

In the event of rain, the AIDS Ride for Life continues. Please dress accordingly and exercise caution on the road.

Covid Changes

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Diner and victory Ride from Cass to Stewart has been cancelled for the 2021 Ride. Join us at the Cass Park pitstop from noon to 5:00pm for food from local restaurants, music, and fun! All Riders are given two meal coupons good for one meal and one drink (each) from the food trucks at Cass Park.

PACKET PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS – STEWART PARK

Friday, September 10, 4-7pm – Large Pavilion

- Stop at the Rider Check In table in the large pavilion, give the volunteer your name.
- You will be instructed by our volunteers where to go next.
- If you have money to turn in, please go to the Rider Check In table first then to the Donations table.
- If you have fulfilled your fundraising obligation, taken your safety quiz & signed your waiver - go directly to the packet pickup table!

WHAT'S IN YOUR RIDER PACK & WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WITH IT ALL!

- **Rider helmet number** - remove backing and adhere to your helmet
- **Rider bib number** - pin on your jersey using the 4 safety pins included in this pack. There are extra pins in the Stewart Park Pavillion.
- **Your emergency contact information is located on the back of your bib. Please check to make sure this is accurate. If not, please change it & notify us!**
- **2 Wristbands with rider number on them** - Place 1 band on your wrist and 1 on your bike.
- **Day of Instructions and explanation** - this is your event agenda & other useful information
- **Rider cue sheet/map** - Carry this with you on your Ride! The cue sheet contains the road instructions and the map outlines the routes and Pit Stop destinations.
- **Road Safety sheet** - Please read - we can never have enough refresher courses on Safety!
- **5 Rider Raffle tickets - Make sure your Rider number on the back of the tickets** & place in the bag in front of the raffle item you would like to win. The raffle table will be open on Friday at Packet Pick up from 4-7pm and on Saturday from 5am - 1:00pm. Winning tickets will be drawn after the 14-25 miler bus leave prizes will be given to Riders with the t-shirts at Cass Park.

Important! Late Rider Implementations

LATE STARTERS - A registered Rider who arrives at Stewart Park after the designated route start times may have their route shortened and put on the corresponding shorter route bus.

At 5pm - Riders under 18 will be picked up and transported to the finish line.

At 5pm - Riders over 18 may be offered a ride by SAG. Any Rider who declines signs a statement of decline.
